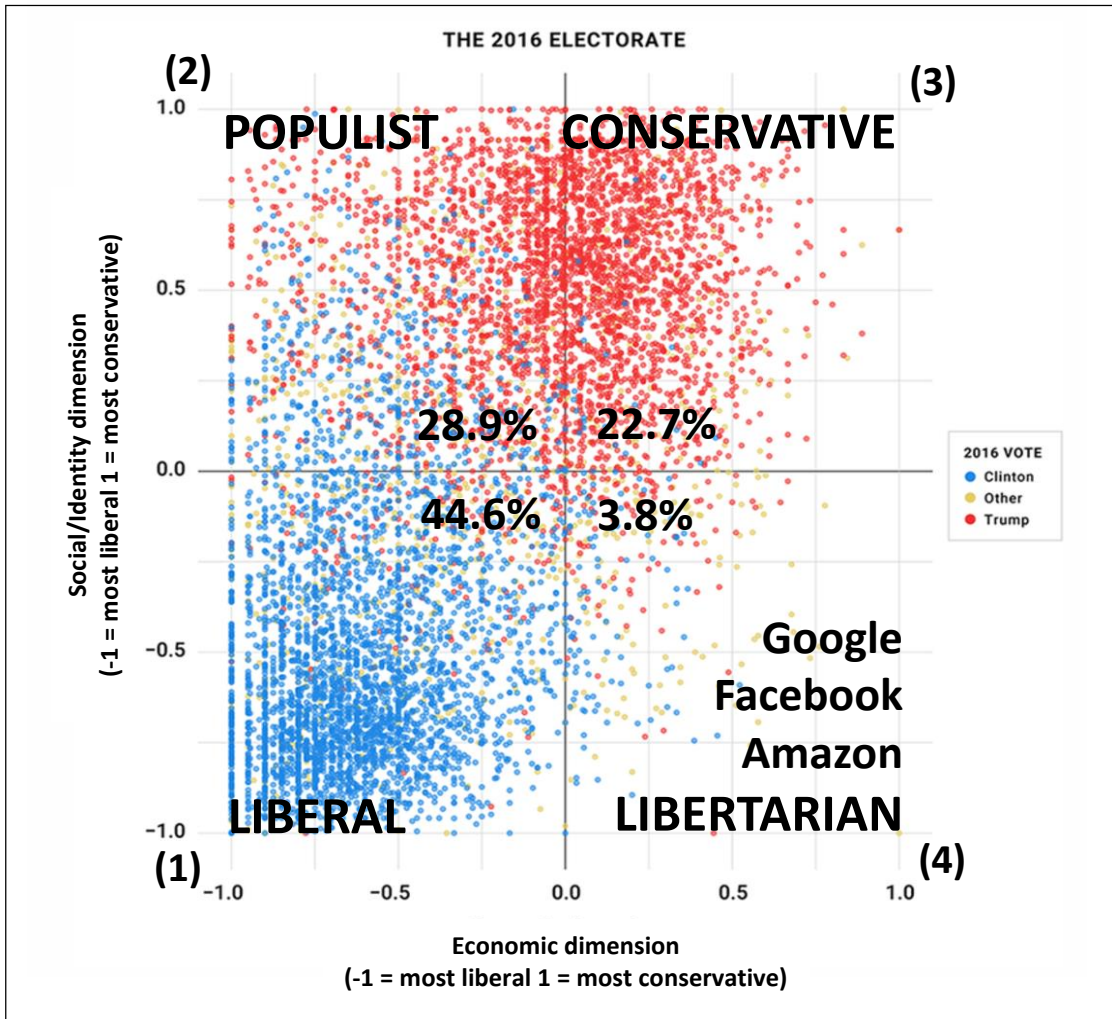


Google Facebook & Amazon's Tech Libertarian Political Values Contrasted with the 2016 American Electorate's Political Values:

(1) Economically liberal/socially liberal	Liberal	44.6%
(2) Economically liberal/socially conservative	Populist	28.9%
(3) Economically conservative/socially conservative	Conservative	22.7%
(4) Economically conservative/socially liberal	Libertarian	3.8%

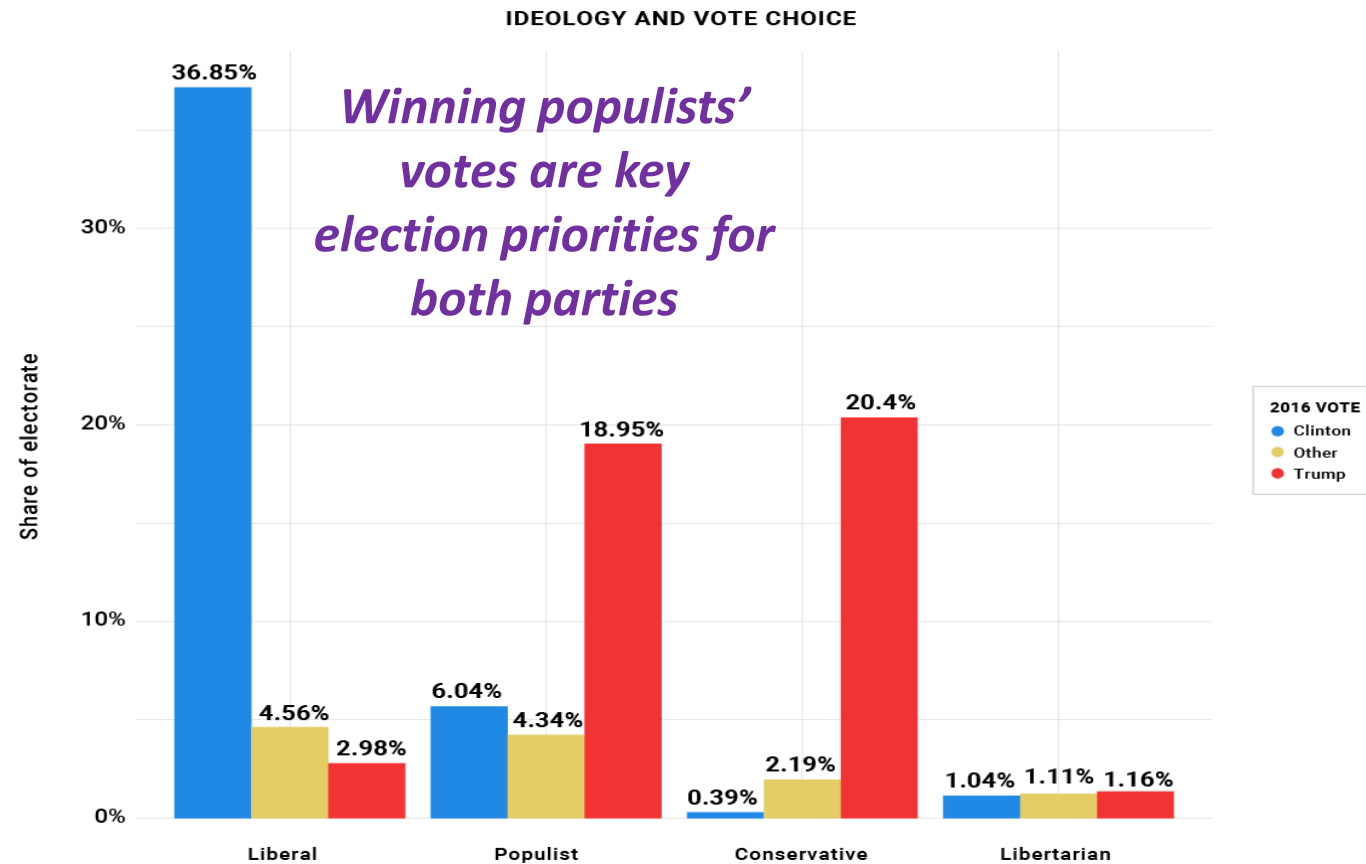
